Reremoana School Move-a-thon

Every second year we do an 'athon' as a major fundraiser as well as a learning opportunity linked to our curriculum - you might remember 2022's Spell-athon. This year we are doing a Move-athon! For 2 weeks our students will be stepping, jumping, dancing, running and moving through this Move-a-thon to get fit, active, and support our school. Funds raised by this super active and fun Move-athon will be put towards wet day board games for the classrooms to ease those rainy lunchtimes, as well as our big new project: a carved waharoa for the entrance to our school that pays respect to our mana whenua, the history and name of our school, and celebrate our cultural diversity. By supporting this fundraiser you are encouraging our tamariki to be active, have some fun, and also making our school be a better place for all our students. Thank you for supporting Reremoana School.

How does a Move-athon work? Students will set a goal that requires them to move more than they usually do, over a 2 week period, 5-18th August. Over these 2 weeks they will record their moving activity on the log sheet that has come home with this notice. There will be activities before and after school and during break times for students to opt into. Keep an eye on HERO and Facebook for information about some community based activities/after school activities. On Friday 16th August we'll have a grand Move-athon event at school with lots of fun movement activities for students to participate in and to help them reach their goal.

How does the fundraising work? This year we have, once again, partnered with online fundraising company Go Raise It so students can collect sponsorship. Collecting sponsorship online makes it super easy for everyone - no more door knocking, your child can collect more donations from further afield (friends & family living overseas, work colleagues etc) and no need to worry about handling cash!

How do I sign my child up to fundraise online? Each child can sign up for their very own fundraising web page to send out to collect online sponsorship from anyone, anywhere!

Prizes: We have a great range of fundraising prizes available including spot prizes and overall fundraising prizes for hubs and individuals.

Next week we'll start giving out spot prizes for those who have set up a fundraising page and started getting donations. There will be spot prize draws throughout our Move-athon.

<u>Grand Prize draw:</u> Everyone who raises over \$50 goes into the prize draw - 1 ticket for every \$50 dollars raised. Raise \$50 AND reach your goal of movement hours and get 2 tickets. Every extra \$50 raised gets you an extra ticket e.g. raise \$200 and reach your goal of movement hours and 5 tickets!

<u>Highest Fundraisers:</u>

1st place - \$200 voucher of your choice 2nd place - \$150 voucher of your choice 3rd place - \$100 voucher of your choice

Hub Prize:

The hub that raises the most* gets TO DESIGN THEIR OWN REWARD!
