

Winter Term Ills and Chills

As the winter weather starts to creep in it is time to talk about keeping people well and safe. COVID is very active in our community again and this is impacting on the health and wellbeing of staff and students.

You should keep your child home from school if they are:

- too sick to learn and need time to rest and recover
- have symptoms of concern including fever, vomiting, diarrhoea, sore throat, skin infections such as school sores, a new rash or difficulty breathing - stay home till fully recovered
- have an infectious illness and have been advised to stay home by their local public health team or their healthcare provider.



Even though your child may seem well enough to attend school, it is still possible they could have an infectious illness including COVID, that they could pass on. Remind them to cover coughs and wash their hands regularly to help reduce spreading germs to others.
